\* Students will be required to register for PHRD 627a - Longitudinal Elective Pharmacy Practice IPPE (2 units), PHRD 629a – Longitudinal Community Pharmacy Practice IPPE (2 units), and PHRD 631a - Longitudinal Hospital Pharmacy Practice IPPE (2 units) as indicated in the schedule above. Students will need to register for the associated PHRD 6XXb courses until they have completed the 80 hours of IPPE associated with each PHRD 6XXa course. Students will be given a grade of Credit (CR) in PHRD 6XXa once the 80 IPPE hours have been successfully completed.

\*\* Students assigned to a Winter IPPE will be enrolled in the specific course during the preceding Fall semester.

\*\*\* Students must complete one 3-unit elective in order to graduate. Students who register for an approved PHRD elective will not be charged any extra tuition.

\*\*\*\* Courses are 10 weeks each in Spring P3.

\*\*\*\*\* Students may be assigned to one 6-unit APPE starting in spring (late March or early April) of their P3 year.
